Dalhousie	We have not yet gone live with our enhancement of photos on class rosters, but we are expecting to in the very near future. We will be providing a photo display option through our online class list functionality available to faculty and advisors. Dalhousie's student system is Sungard's BANNER and we are also using their Web products such as web for Student and Web for Faculty and Advisors. The enhancements we are making are not baseline, of course. I'd be happy to answer any questions I can for you regarding our experience to date. King's University College	We do not show student photos on official class rosters, but have distributed a pictorial class list for a number of years. Due to production time, this comes a couple of days after the official class lists are distributed. 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Lakehead	How it works:When faculty access their class roster there is now a button for them to click on that allows them to download the class roster with a signature line. All students must sign the roster allowing their photo to be attached. The instructor also signs a statement on it recognizing confidentiality... Malaspina University College	We set this up three years ago and the faculty members love it. It works like this: If you are the instructor of a class, you can access either a class list or a class roster online. It's password protected so only the instructor can access it. The class list has typical information such as name, student number, program, email address or phone number. The class roster just has students' pictures (from the student card database) and names.
