1. Acadia University			Dean's List only.
2. Alberta College of Art & Design	X	A student who receives a semester GPA of 3.67 or higher on a minimum 12 credits is placed on our President's Honour Roll and a notation appears on the transcript beneath the academic standing line for the semester.	
3. Briercrest College	X	A semester GPA of 3.70 on a 4.0 scale.	
4. Brock University			Dean's List only.
5. Capilano College			<p><i>Dean's List:</i> 3.67 or higher grade point average, have no Incompletes, no No Credit Granted or Fail grades and have completed a minimum of 12 credits for that term.</p> <p><i>Merit List:</i> 3.67 GPA or higher on both their Term Grade point Average and Cumulative grade Point Average, have no Incompletes, no No Credit Granted or Fail grades and not be eligible for the Dean's List.</p> <p><i>Governor-General's Collegiate Bronze Medal:</i> this award is presented to a diploma graduate from a two-year program who has achieved the highest cumulative grade point average, and who has attained this grade point average on a minimum of 15 credit hours per term, or full program load as outlined in the Calendar, during attendance at Capilano College.</p> <p><i>Lieutenant Governor's Silver Medal:</i> awarded for academic excellence and contribution to the College and community to a graduate in a Career/Vocational program of less than two years' duration. 7. Malaspina University-College			Dean's List only.
8. McMaster University	X	Our Provost Honour Roll Medal is awarded each year to outstanding students with a 12.0 average on at least 30 units (usually their Sessional Average) are named to the Provost's Honour Roll. Students will always be assessed at the same time and using the same average calculation as applied to the Deans' Honour List assessment.	
9. Nipissing University			One of our major scholarships is based on similar criteria to that used for a Dean's List and the scholarship notation is included on the transcript.

10. Nova Scotia Agricultural College	X	The top 10% of students within each program of study (degree, Engineering, Technician, Technology) will be included on the President's List. These students must have a term average of 80% or higher, have been enrolled in four or more courses, and have no failures (including Drop Fails).	
11. Redeemer University College	X	A 9.5/12 pt scale for full-time enrolment for a term (minimum of 4 courses a term).	
12. Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Science & Technology			We used to have a Principal's List at some of our campuses. We have replaced this concept with an honourable mention on the transcript, and parchment. Students may graduate with distinction (CPGA 85.0-89.9%) or great distinction (CPGA 90.0-100.0%).
13. The King's University College			Rather the student can earn honour's for the semester based upon the semester's GPA 3.5/4 for most programs. A notation appears on the student's transcript under the semester in question: Awarded Honours Standing.
14. Trent University	X	The equivalent of the Principal's List would be our President's Honour Roll. All graduating students who achieve an overall cumulative average of A- (80%) or better have their names placed on the President's Honour Roll.	
15. University of Guelph			Dean's List only.
16. University of Manitoba	X	We are developing something we call the President's Scholars program which is rather different in structure; here we would be identifying the very best students coming to us from high-school (with minimum high-school averages of, say, 95%) who would then be eligible for a renewable award guarantee (provided certain minimum standards are maintained) along with a number of other benefits (most of which have not yet been identified).
