

	When does your institution require final tuition/fees payment for fall and winter semesters?	Does your institution send students an invoice before this date?
Langara	At Langara the fee payment policy is "eclectic". The general deadline is 2 weeks before the beginning of classes (students are dropped from all courses if fees are unpaid). Students who register in courses after this date must pay fees immediately. Non-payment for these "late" registrants does not result in being dropped from courses, but rather they are simply assessed the usual interest and late payment charges. The combinations and permutations of this makes Visio complain when I try to flowchart them.	We don't send invoices. Students are required to access their account information online - their account is updated immediately following their registration transactions. Students with outstanding account balances are sent notices every month.
UCFV	At the stable date, usually end of the second full week of classes	No
NorthWest	At stabilization date	No. We either withdraw if they're not attending or send reminder after due date.
Kwantlen	At the census enrolment date - second week of classes - for final payment. However, we require a tuition payment 3 weeks prior to the start of classes for all registration activity thus far. Failure to pay by this date will result in the student being dropped from their classes. Failure to pay by the final payment date does not result in a withdrawal from classes.	No
CNC	Final tuition payments are required approximately 2 weeks prior to the start of classes.	No, we do not invoice.
TWU	TWU's Payments Schedule is as follows. Fall (Sep - Dec): 50% due on first Friday in August; balance due October 15th. Spring (Jan - Apr): 50% due on first Friday in December; balance due February 15th.	We advise students by email in mid July and mid November to view their first payment information on the Student Portal.
